Each student will have the weekly opportunity to put their name on this board. The weekly requirements are...

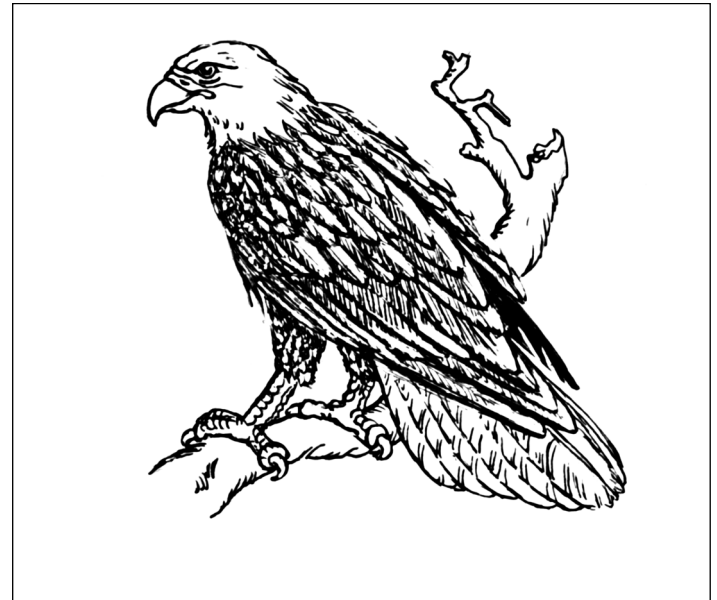
- Attend one church service - your church

## WELCOME BACK

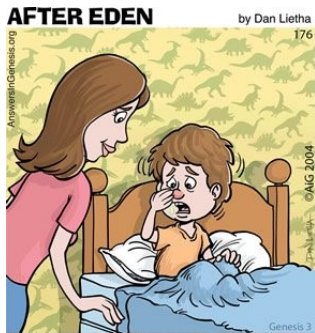
